Kindergarten for the 24-25 Year:

This past year, the Connecticut General Assembly modified the age for Kindergarten attendance, requiring children to be age 5 by September 1st to be automatically enrolled in Kindergarten. For the 2024-2025 school year, families with children who will not turn 5 by September 1, 2024, can make a written request to the district, asking for their child to be assessed to help determine possible eligibility. More information on Kindergarten admittance and the new entrance age requirements can be found on the website of the <u>Connecticut Office of Early</u>

<u>Childhood</u>. Information regarding making a written request for the district to conduct an assessment will be shared in January along with information on Kindergarten registration.

Our district is currently conducting a preschool census. This information will ensure that the district can plan for appropriate levels of resources and staffing. Please consider completing it. Doing so will also add you to our mailing list for the most up to date information regarding Kindergarten registration here in Avon.


